### **Our initiatives include**

- Engage with other Outdoor and Environmental Education Centres to intentionally collaborate to share best practice in programs, coaching and teaching practice senior biology, themed programs, pedagogical approaches (Pedagogy partnership with Tallebudgera OEEC)
- Undertake a refreshment professional development in collegial coaching to continue to build staff capability
- Strategically release teaching staff to write programs plans and develop resources aligned with Australian Curriculum content and overlayed with BIEEC whole school approach to pedagogy
- Strategically release teaching staff to undertake collegial coaching cycles as both a coach and for
