- Engage with other Outdoor and Environmental Education Centres to intentionally collaborate to share best practice in programs and initiatives – senior biology, themed programs, STEM implementation
- Strategically release teaching staff to write programs, resources, lessons – aligned with Australian Curriculum content and overlaid with BIEEC Pedagogical framework lens
- Strategically purchase up to date STEM and technology devices that are implemented into programs and support student learning through engagement
- Engage human resources for administration of safety management systems and documents for curriculum programs

Provide release time for teaching staff to implement curriculum projects through liaison with other OEEC's – TRS release – curriculum plan, curriculum packages etc. (5 x TRS days @ \$457/day)	\$ 2,285
Strategic purchase of STEM technology to support programs – Microscopes (approx. \$350 x 8)	\$ 2,809
Providing human resources through TRS release to update safety management systems of the Centre's boating program (3 x TRS days @ \$457/day)	\$ 1,371
